DETAILED SCHEDULE ~ 4/5

① Challah Baking:

Each child receives dough and braids it. Sprinkle toppings and bake.

② Havdallah Craft:

Each child will be making a Havdallah “Plant.” Children will receive a flower pot, a piece of clay, a colored pencil or round stick, a styrofoam ball, cloves and tulle. Children can paint miniature flower pots, insert the piece of clay and stick the pencil in it, standing up securely. While it dries they stick the cloves into the small styrofoam ball, all they way around, then the ball should be stuck half way into the pencil that’s standing in the pot. Tulle should be draped over the ball and then gathered at the bottom, around the pencil, tying it with string. In addition, children can also make quick and easy candles by rolling wax sheets around a few wicks.

⑥ Search for Chametz:

Ten pieces of chametz are wrapped up in paper for each bunk – each bunk’s chametz is wrapped in a different color paper. Campers are given a swatch of their color paper and have to find all 10 pieces. The first bunk to find all 10 pieces wins.

⑦ Holiday Carnival:

- R.H. : Guess how many seeds in the pomegranate (marshmallow & choc. chips)
- Yom Kippur: Race to wrap a friend in toilet paper
- Play the Purim Lotto
- Chanukah: Find the Chanukah gelt in the flour

- Pesach: Race to drink the 4 cups of wine – punch race (only 1 cup)

SUPPLIES NEEDED

① Challah Baking:

- Challah dough and toppings (i.e. chocolate chips, sprinkles, sesame, poppy, onion, etc.)
- Tablecloths & baking sheets
- Popsicle sticks to “label” challah

② Havdallah Craft:

- Miniature Plant Pots & Clay
- Pencils or round sticks
- Styrofoam balls and cloves
- Paint, Scissors, String
- Tulle
- Optional: Wax sheets and wicks for easy havdallah candle making

⑥ Search for Chametz

- Wrapped pieces of bread

SUPPLIES NEEDED CONTINUED
7 Holiday Carnival:

- **R.H. : guess how many seeds in the pomegranate**
Marshmallow fluff, chocolate chips and dozens of plastic spoons.
- **Yom Kippur: race to wrap a friend in toilet paper**
Toilet paper
- **Play The Purim Lotto**
Lotto cards and pens
- **Chanukah: find the Chanukah gelt in the flour**
2 bowls of flour with 10 pennies in each. (straws, optional)
- **Purim: guess how many items there are in the Mishloach Manot basket**
Prepare a shalach manot basket with many items. Winner gets basket.
- **Make a hamantash: Children fill hamantash dough and bake at home**
Dough, spoons, jam, flour, plates, plastic bags,
- **Pesach: race to drink the 4 cups of wine – punch race**
Punch, 5 oz. cups & straws
- **Shavuos: pin the Torah onto har sinai**
Poster of Har Sinai and small Torah, blindfold & lots of scotch tape
- **Send a happy holiday gram**
Holiday grams with candies attached; markers
- **Make Carnival Maps for campers. As they complete or win each booth, they get their map stamped. When a child gets his entire map stamped – after completing or winning every booth – he can go choose a prize.**
- **Have a box of prizes for each child who gets their entire map signed**

NOTE:

- All children who come dressed up in pajamas get a special popcorn prize – popcorn keychain, eraser, etc.
- For the last 10 minutes of shiur, children each get a box of popcorn (or popcorn in popcorn cup) and sit down on the floor with pillows to watch the Pesach segment from Miracle Days.
